- I am an attorney at law duly licensed to practice in the State of New York and 1. am a member of the law firm of Patterson Belknap Webb & Tyler LLP, attorneys for William H. Cosby, Jr., Defendant in the above-captioned action. I submit this declaration in support of Defendant's special motion to strike Plaintiff's complaint pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 425.16. Unless otherwise specified, I have personal knowledge of the matters set forth in this declaration.
 - I have represented Mr. Cosby since 1983. 2.
- On November 18, 2014, in an interview with Entertainment Tonight, Plaintiff 3. Janice Dickinson accused Mr. Cosby of having drugged and raped her after they had dinner in Lake Tahoe, CA in 1982. Ms. Dickinson also said that she tried to write about the alleged assault in her 2002 autobiography No Lifeguard on Duty: The Accidental Life of the World's First Supermodel ("Book"), but, she claimed, when she submitted the draft of her full story to her publisher, HarperCollins, Mr. Cosby and his lawyers pressured her and the publisher to remove the details.
- On February 9, 2015, I participated in a telephone conference with Ms. 4. Dickinson's attorney, Lisa Bloom. On that call, Ms. Bloom stated that she was retracting Ms. Dickinson's allegation that Mr. Cosby's lawyers had pressured HarperCollins to remove the rape story from the Book.
